Literacy	<p>Reading</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Finish reader <i>Globby Helps Out</i>. Continue to revise <i>Ella Goes to the Airport</i> and <i>The Wrong Car</i> (all available at https://my.cjfallon.ie/dashboard/student-resources)• Tricky words: Practise reading and writing the first three sets of tricky words. Write them out and play games such as snap, go fish etc. <u>Blue set</u>: I, the, he, she, me, we, be, was, to, do, are, all <u>Yellow set</u>: you, your, come, some, said, here, there, they, go, no, so, my <u>Red set</u>: one, by, only, old, like, have, live, give, little, down, what, when• Daily Story Time - Choose children's own favourite titles• Twinkl Story - Saving Easter (Free access to Twinkl for parents) Read, make predictions, discuss pictures, alternative endings etc. https://www.twinkl.ie/resource/t-l-52624-saving-easter-ebook• Listen to free audio books by David Walliams. One new story is put up every day (https://www.worldofdavidwalliams.com/elevenses/) <p>Writing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue writing daily news/ diary• Independent writing: "The Easter Bunny" (Discuss, draw a picture and write sentences about the Easter bunny e.g. The Easter bunny is brown. He has lots of eggs. The bunny likes to hop.) "Easter Sunday" (Discuss why we celebrate Easter, what we do, eat, etc. Discuss SESE PowerPoints.)• Reminders: Capital letters and full stops. Correct letter formation. Tripod pencil grip.• Spring Activity Pack and Easter Activity Pack (Younger) contains puzzles, colouring, jigsaws, tracing and more. 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	<p>Phonics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Revise all letter names, sounds and digraphs (ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo, ch, sh, th, qu, ou, oi, ue, er, ar) • Dictation based on digraphs: Sample of words to dictate based on 'ie' - pie, fries, cried, lied etc. Sample of sentences to dictate based on 'ee': I see a bee in a tree. The sheep are in the green grass. • Jolly Phonics Rule: Short vowels and double letters Revise short vowels (a, e, i, o, u) After a short vowel there is often a double letter eg. Huff, egg, mill, dinner, mess, supper, butter, fell, buzz. Write a list of these words. Look for words with this rule in stories. Dictate some of the words for children to write.
<p>Maths</p>	<p>Planet Maths ebook is available free on Folens Online. Register as a teacher. For roll no. use code: Prim20</p> <p>Prepositional Language: on top of, under, between, below, above, in, beside etc. Play a game, following instructions, drawing pictures using this language. See Planet Maths p.88,89,90 for reference.</p> <p>Counting</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Counting forwards to 100 in 1s and 10s • Counting backwards from 20 to 1 • Counting forwards in 2s to 50 (odd numbers/even numbers) • Lots of Jack Hartmann and Scratch Garden videos on YouTube to help with counting • Skip counting forwards/backwards on a number line. Eg. Start on 4 and go on 3 jumps. Start on 8 and go back 3 jumps etc. See Planet Maths p. 99, 100, 101 for reference <p>Easter egg hunt using Maths problems and prepositional language. Simple problem solving: 5 Easter eggs and 4 Easter eggs. How many altogether?... I eat 2 eggs. How many are left? etc.</p> <p>The Story of 10: Ask children how many ways you make 10 using 2 numbers. Write out the 11 ways. Make sets of 10 (Lego, Cheerios etc.) and partition them to help. See Planet Maths p. 94 for reference.</p>

SESE	<p>Easter Traditions - bonnets, hunting for eggs, painting eggs, going to Mass etc. https://www.twinkl.ie/resource/the-easter-journal-easter-traditions-powerpoint-t-or-1314</p> <p>Easter around the world - Research different countries and how they celebrate Easter https://www.twinkl.ie/resource/roi-t-t-9477-easter-around-the-world-powerpoint</p>
SPHE	<p>Make an Easter card and post it to a relative. Include some pictures and a short message.</p> <p>Continue with good personal hygiene practice as last week: hand washing, coughing, sneezing into elbow etc.</p>
Arts	<p>Draw and decorate some Easter eggs. Cut them out and stick them onto a drawing of an Easter basket or make an Easter basket e.g. from a paper plate.</p> <p>Draw an Easter bunny.
