• Reminders: Capital letters and full stops. Correct letter formation. Tripod pencil grip.
• Letter formation: Jj Children can copy your writing in their copy.

	 Phonics: Continue to revise all letter names, sounds and digraphs (ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo, ch, sh, th, qu, ou, oi, ue, er, ar) Dictation based on digraphs – focus on sh this week: Sample of words to dictate based on 'sh'- shell, sheep, shed, ship, shampoo, fish, brush, dish, wash, mash, wash. Sample of sentences to dictate based on 'sh': I need shampoo. I wash the dish. The sheep is in the shed. I have fish and mash. I get shells at the beach. Can you see the ship? Jolly Phonics Rule: magic 'e' makes a vowel say its name.
	 Revise "a-e" and "i-e" words, see previous 2 plans.

	Reference pages 108- 111 inclusive Topic: Money
	Continue work on money. Revise the coins, play shop.
	 Recognise and name the following coins (1c,2c,5c,10c,20c) Understand the value of 'c' e.g. 5 x1c =5c Add coins up to totals of 10c Match appropriate coins to correct amount of money Exchange a number of coins for a single coin of equal value (5c, 5c =10c coin, 2c,2c,1c = 5c coin) Set up a shop at home using empty boxes and cartons or maybe toy food if you have some. Label the items with a price up to 20c. Give the children real coins up to 20c to play with. Have someone play the role of shopkeeper and customer(s). Encourage the children to work out what coins they need to purchase items and also if they need change.
