### **TO: Parents of Children in Second Standard**

**Dear Parents** 

As you are aware the Government has published the *Roadmap for Reopening Society and Business*. This sees a Five Phase reopening over 15 weeks. Phase 1 is due to begin May 18<sup>th</sup>. The document is described as "living" and the schedule offered may change in response to the progression or suppression of the disease. While it is very disappointing not be able to see the children before the summer, for now we will continue to post the worklists and support the children's learning via e-mail.

While the situation remains very fluid we can now begin to plan for the coming year. I write to share these plans with you.

#### **REOPENING & SAFETY**

A Phased reopening of schools is planned from the beginning of the academic year 2020/21. As we share a campus with the Senior school, we must consider the school population of approximately 1350 pupils and 150 staff who are onsite on any given school day. This is before any parents come onsite. This presents with considerable challenges with regard to social distancing requirements. We will look to the Department of Education & Skills and Patron for guidance on these issues.

The Safety of all is the priority for both Boards and they must be satisfied that the school can meet all requirements from the Department of Education & Skills and NPHET.

## COMMUNION

We were looking forward to a very nice day on Saturday, but unfortunately like other schools around the country have had our children's ceremonies postponed. We hope that you and your families do something nice on Saturday.

Fr Des is hoping that Communions may be held over the summer. This will be a church decision and Fr Des will inform you should he permitted to do so. These will probably be on a smaller scale and subject to Diocesan guidelines.

## TRANSFER ARRANGEMENTS TO 3RD CLASS IN HOLY FAMILY SENIOR SCHOOL

I have been speaking with Ms Gowen, Principal of Holy Family Senior School. You will see from her letter that she plans to keep our current Second Classes in their current class groupings for 3<sup>rd</sup> Class.
