Literacy	<p><u>Reading:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Practice the new sight words for the next reader '<u>The Beach House</u>'. Teacher will email a power point with the final 16 words to practice.• Start the reader '<u>The Beach House</u>' two pages a day. Teacher will email the comprehension questions.• <u>Tricky words</u>: Revise the 4 sets we have done to date - red, yellow, blue, green.• <u>Story Time</u>: Libraries Ireland have a lovely resource where you can join a story time session by the author from a particular library, have a look if you want: https://www.librariesireland.ie/services/right-to-read/spring-into-storytime• <u>Oxford Owl</u> offer a free eBook library for 3 - 11 year olds. You can also check which level is right for your child with a quick test. Visit https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page/ <p><u>Writing:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Continue writing My news/My diary (Once a week).• Independent writing: Write a letter or a postcard to someone you are missing. Teachers will email a prompt to you.• Letter formation: Kk and Zz. Children can copy your writing in their copy. Teacher will email the sample.• Reminders: Capital letters and full stops. Correct letter formation. Tripod pencil grip.
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Phonics:

- Continue to revise all letter names, sounds and digraphs (ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo, ch, sh, th, qu, ou, oi, ue, er, ar)
- Dictation based on digraphs – focus on ‘ou and oi’ this week:
- Sample of words to dictate based on 'ou and oi' - **sour, mouth, cloud, shout, out, couch, soil, boil, coin, spoilt, point, oil etc.**
- Sample of sentences to dictate based on ‘ou and oi’ - I sat on the couch. I see a big cloud. The sweet was sour in my mouth. The soil began to boil. My mam said I must not point. She gave me a coin.

- Jolly Phonics Rule: **magic ‘e’** makes a vowel say its name.
- Focus on **u** – followed by **magic ‘e’** makes the short vowel change to the long vowel.
- Look at words with short **u** and see what happens when you add **magic‘e’**
- **cub – cube, tub – tube, cut – cute, hug – huge**
- Write a list of these words. Look for words with this rule in stories.
- Dictate some of the words for children to write.

Counting

- Counting forwards to 100 in 1s and 10s and 5s
- Counting backwards from 40 to 1
- Counting forwards in 2s to 50 (odd numbers/even numbers)
- Revising number formation (0-10)
- Skip counting forwards/backwards on a number line to 20. e.g. Start on 10 and go on 4 jumps. Start on 15 and go back 3 jumps etc.
- Simple Word Problem Practice- If Sam has 3 sweets, Amy has 5 sweets and Darragh has 2 sweets, How many sweets do they have altogether?
- Guess the shape game: I have 6 faces, my faces are square, I can not roll. What am I?
