Literacy

Reading

- <u>Tricky words</u>: Practice the new orange set: once, upon, always, also, of, eight, love, cover, after, every, mother, father

Writing:

- Write your news/diary one day this week.
- Letter formation: Finish the last 2 pages in your handwriting copy. If you wish, continue to catch up on any pages not filled in.
- Independent writing: What can you see in the Summer Garden?
 *Teachers will Email the picture prompt to you.
 Children can write the sentences in their copy and draw a picture to match. e.g. It is hot and sunny. Dad is cooking sausages. Tom and Sarah are in the pool. They will have a barbecue.
- Reminders: Capital letters and full stops. Correct letter formation. Tripod pencil grip.

Phonics:

- Continue to revise all letter names, sounds and digraphs (ai, oa, ie, ee, or, ng, oo, ch, sh, th, qu, ou, oi, ue, er, ar)
- New Jolly Phonics Rule- The letters 'ea' sometimes say the 'ee' sound. List the 'ea' words e.g. tea, bead, lead, seat, mean, cheat, read, deal, meat, beat. Put them into sentences. Here are some links to show you some samples to help you practice and recognise when to use 'ea' instead of 'ee'

Maths

Counting

- Counting forwards to 100 in 1s and 10s and 5s
- Counting backwards from 60 to 1
- Counting forwards in 2s to 70 (odd numbers/even numbers)
- Revising correct number formation (0-10)
- Skip counting forwards/backwards on a number line to 20. e.g. Start on 11 and go on 4 jumps. Start on 17 and go back 6 jumps etc.

Addition

- Adding counting on using fingers e.g. 7+4= Keep 7 in your head, count on 4 using your fingers.
- Dice games roll the dice 2/3 times, add the numbers, who has more?
- Add 3 numerals to totals of 10
- Addition colour by number
- Teacher will email some worksheets to complete/copy
- Children can complete the Planet Maths Number Practice book at their own pace.
